Presidential Address

- 1. House manager: This person would be the first line of contact for issues at the building. You would not be responsible to be there and get everything done but to make phone calls and set up getting things fixed. An example, if the AC/heat system stops working you would be responsible to call Trane and get the ball rolling. Once it has been decided that a tech needs to come out, if you can meet him great, if not we have a group of people with access to the building and any of them would be willing to meet the tech. This would be a great job for someone who is retired and may have a little extra time to get involved in temple business.
- 2. Upcoming president: We have decided to stay on for one more year. After that time we will be looking for someone to take over the presidency. The model of co-presidency has worked for us and we would like to see it continue but to be modified a little bit. We recommend a senior and junior president. Each would be a two-year term. Your first year you would be the junior president and the second year the senior president. Both would work together. This model has many benefits, including and working together, one person isn't responsible for it all. We would like to find someone that would be willing to work with us this year for an easier transition. The person would have a chance to "learn the ropes" before taking on the new responsibility.

If you are interested in either of these, or know someone that might be, please let us know so we can move forward.


